


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WHO WE ARE

WELD CO-OP PROGRAM

At Toyota Material Handling (TMH), a deep commitment to fostering the growth and development of young talent while making a positive impact on society is evident. As part of TMH's enduring dedication to education and youth empowerment, the company proudly collaborates with high school vocational programs, offering a unique Co-Op (Work-Based Learning) opportunity tailored for aspiring welders.

Presently, TMH partners with three esteemed programs – C9, C4, and Seymour Weld – catering to 17 and 18-year-old students seeking to master the art of welding. These students balance traditional academic studies with vocational training, preparing themselves for successful careers. Upon reaching a certain level of proficiency, they become eligible for TMH's Weld Co-Op Program.

During their Co-Op experience, students spend half of their school day at TMH, where they are warmly welcomed as temporary associates. Here, they receive competitive pay and work alongside seasoned professionals, engaging in hands-on training that equips them with practical skills and industry insights.

TMH's Weld Co-Op Program is meticulously designed to provide students with meaningful learning opportunities while contributing to operations. Specific processes within welding areas are identified where Co-Op students can actively participate and receive additional training, with the ultimate goal of preparing them for successful careers and potential full-time positions upon graduation.

To select Co-Op candidates, TMH's team conducts interviews and weld tests, ensuring the identification of individuals who demonstrate both technical proficiency and a strong work ethic. Upon selection,



students undergo onboarding procedures facilitated by Elwood, TMH's staffing partner, before officially joining the workforce.

Currently, TMH is proud to host 12 Co-Op students, with plans to expand to 20 students in both morning and afternoon shifts in the coming years. Students are compensated at a rate of \$21.50 per hour and adhere to a schedule that aligns with their school commitments. Additionally, during school breaks, students have the option to work extra hours, although it is not mandatory.

At TMH, a belief in investing in the future by providing young individuals with opportunities to learn, grow, and succeed is paramount. Through the Weld Co-Op Program, TMH is not only preparing the next generation of welders but also contributing to the development of a skilled workforce that will drive innovation and growth in the industry for years to come.



BARTHOLOMEW CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL CORPORATION



In the domain of education and youth development, cultivating alliances between industry leaders and educational institutions is pivotal. One such outstanding collaboration that highlights the importance of education is between TMH and Bartholomew Consolidated School Corporation (BCSC).
